

## MARKUS JUTZI HEAD MEDICAL TEAM

Interregional blood transfusion service of the Swiss Red Cross

In 1996, Dr. Jutzi obtained his medical diploma from the University of Zurich. He was employed in 1997 as resident physician in neonatology at the Zurich University Hospital. From 1997 to 1999 he joined the microbiology department at the Lucerne cantonal Hospital. Between 2000 and 2006, he worked for the University of Basel, the Cantonal Hospital of Aarau, the Zurich University Hospital, and the Cantonal Hospital of Basel. During these years, he specialized in medical microbiology, also working in the fields of Immunology, Haemostaseology, and transfusion medicine.

From 2006 to 2016, Dr. Jutzi has been working for Swissmedic (the Swiss Agency for therapeutic products) at the safety of medicines department, as clinical reviewer in Haemovigilance and risk management. During this period, he was also representative for Switzerland in the WHO Blood Regulators Network and at the European Committee on Blood Transfusion (CD-P-TS) at the European Directorate for the Quality of Medicines (EDQM). In 2016 he was Head of the infectious diseases unit at the Cantonal health department of Lucerne.

Today, Dr. Jutzi is Head of the medical team at the Interregional blood transfusion service of the Swiss Red Cross. He is a member of the Swiss Society of Microbiology and the Swiss Association for Transfusion Medicine.
